Coexisting with wildlife at home is as easy as checking off these impactful actions:

- ☐ Secure food waste and garbage in trash cans
- ☐ Keep pet food inside
- ☐ Close off openings and crawl spaces around your home
- ☐ Choose alternative rodent traps - never use glue traps or rodenticide
- ☐ Provide secure, enclosed shelters for pets that stay outside
- ☐ Offer a bird bath as an alternative to a bird feeder which can attract unwanted wildlife

- ☐ Clean barbecue grills and picnic spaces after use
- ☐ Keep a safe distance from wildlife
- ☐ Drive slowly in areas where wild animals cross

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
